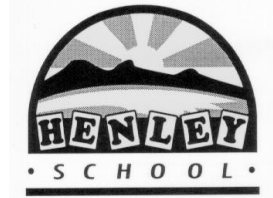


## JUNIOR SYNDICATE STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS – TERM 1 2012

Listed below are the stationery requirements for your child to begin the 2012 school year.

Stationery for the start of 2012 will be sold on the same basis as for the start of this year. School Supplies is the school's stationery supplier and provides good quality, reasonably priced stationery. At the end of the 2011 school year your child will be given a list of the stationery they will require for the start of the 2012 school year. Stationery packs can be obtained by one of two methods as described below;

1. Orders can be placed online by going to the school's website at [www.henley.school.nz](http://www.henley.school.nz) Go to the Stationery page of the website (there are two links to this on the Home Page) where there will be a link to the School Supplies website. This link will take you directly to Henley School's area within the website.  
  
Once in the website choose the pack that your child will require. If you have stationery left from 2011 which you wish your child to use next year you can 'un tick' items. Once you have finalised your order and made payment the stationery will be posted to you. To ensure that your stationery arrives before school starts you should place your order by around the 14<sup>th</sup> January.
2. School Supplies retail outlet is Office Max at 144 Trafalgar Street, Nelson and they will have some ready made packs available. All you need to do is show them the stationery list you will be provided with at the end of the 2011 school year or let them know which school and which pack you require. However, if purchasing a ready made pack from Office Max it is not possible to have items you do not require removed from the pack. Packs will be available from the beginning of January.

School Supplies supports the school with a small financial rebate based on the value of purchases made through them by Henley school families.

Alternatively, you may use the stationery list to purchase your child's stationery elsewhere.

Copies of the stationery lists will be posted at the end of the 2011 school year on the office doors, in the noticeboard by the library and on the school's website on the Stationery page.

The school expects that students will all have their stationery with them on the first day of school (Tuesday 7 February 2012) ready to commence work.

The school office will continue to sell 'top up' stationery throughout the year.
