Henley School has an online payment service available to our families with Kindo. Kindo is the preferred way for our parents to pay the school and is how children are registered to play sport, pay for class trips, buy disco tickets, order sausages for sausage sizzles along with most types of other payments to the school. Later this year parents will also be able to order 'top up' stationery for their children via their myKindo accounts and the stationery will be delivered to your child the next day. No more scrabbling for cash!

To transfer funds to your myKindo account to use for your payments you can use PoLi or bank transfer (no fees) or Visa, Mastercard, American Express, UnionPay (fees apply). If you like, you can schedule regular top-ups to your myKindo account, then allocate payments to the school when you're ready. All these are available through your myKindo app. If you don't already have your myKindo account set up, please register now by using the link <https://support.mykindo.co.nz> or via the link on our website at www.henley.school.nz Search for the 'myKindo' app on the App Store or Google Play for your myKindo app.
