Update to parents-6 September 2021 COVID-19 Alert Level 2

Dear parents and caregivers
Kia ora koutou e te whānau

I was delighted to hear the message from the Prime Minister today outlining a shift to **COVID Alert Level 2**. We are now in a position of being able to share further information regarding returning to school under Alert Level 2.

Key Messages:

- School will resume for all children on **Thursday 9th September** as the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health state that under Alert Level 2 it is safe for schools to open. All children are expected to attend.
- Safe and sensible practices for hygiene and contact tracing will be the norm
- Keeping children home who are unwell will be very important at Level 2

Specific Henley School Messages:

- Masks are strongly recommended at school but not a requirement. Staff and students are asked to bring their own mask, should they choose to wear one.
- As we are required to maintain contact tracing records for visitors to the site (including parents) we ask you to drop your children at the William Street or Gilbert Street entrance. - Our Office will be open in a limited form as we are required to operate under public health requirements – please consider whether your visit is necessary
- We will not be holding assemblies or mass gatherings at this time
