



Update to parents – 14 June 2022

Dear Parents and Caregivers

It is hard to believe we are now in to the second half of Term 2. Thank you for your continued patience with the changes we have made at the Orange Light setting. At present, our students are all playing in shared areas of the playgrounds at break times and the Covid positive numbers remain low.

We still track the daily Covid case numbers in our school and taking this information into account over the last few weeks, we feel we can now invite you to drop off and pick up your children at their classroom doors from the morning of Wednesday 15 June. Teachers will be available to come out and see you on afternoons that they are not on duty. As a result, the Junior Syndicate teachers will no longer be bringing their students to the top court and Junior Playground area at the end of the day. Please ensure you talk to your child about where you will meet them at the 3.00pm bell.

Please only enter classrooms and school buildings if absolutely necessary and if you do, please wear a mask.

We encourage everyone to continue wearing masks when on the school grounds while Covid-19 is still active in our community.

You will be aware that anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 is still required to isolate for seven days, along with all of their household contacts. Day 0 is the day symptoms began or the day the test was taken (whichever came first). Positive cases will isolate for a full seven days and are free to return to normal activities on Day 8, if they are not symptomatic.

Thank you for your support as we continue to manage the Omicron variant of Covid-19 in our community. We appreciate all you are doing to keep our community safe.
