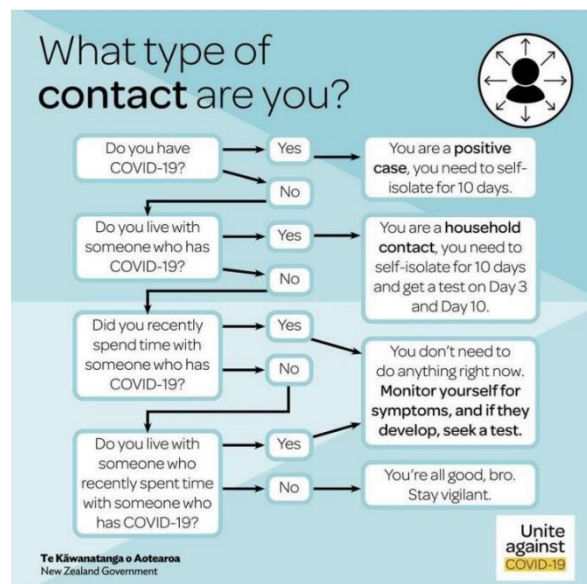
### COVID-19 Red Level Setting-Phase 3

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Thank you all for your support as we manage the increasing spread of the Omicron variant and try to keep everyone safe. We now have a very small number of confirmed positive Covid-19 cases in our school community.

It is important that you monitor your children and if they develop symptoms, please ensure you keep them home and get them tested. If your child or a member of your household receives a positive test result, please email our school office as soon as possible [office@henley.school.nz](mailto:office@henley.school.nz) and include your child's name and classroom. We appreciate all you are doing to support our community.

As we are now in Phase 3 of the Red Setting, if a household contact tests positive, your household members need to self-isolate for 10 days. Please see the flow-chart below.



A friendly reminder that Year 5/6 children continue to be required to wear face masks and that the rest of our students are encouraged to do so as well.
