

Out of School Use of Henley Pool 2022-2023



The Henley Board of Trustees will make the Henley School pool available for Henley families to use during the coming swimming season. A key can be hired for \$50.00 via parent's myKindo accounts. A copy of these rules will be supplied at the time the key is collected. The right to use the pool is a privilege granted by the Board of Trustees and they have the authority to close the pool at any time.

Please note the pool must close at 7pm daily (health regulations require the pool to be tested 3 hourly).

<u>Pool is open for public use</u>	<u>Christmas school holidays</u>	- (seven days a week) - 10am to 7pm
	<u>During school term time</u>	- 4pm to 7pm Monday to Friday
		- 10am to 7pm Saturdays & Sundays

All keys must be returned by 31 March 2023

If swimming lessons are in progress key holders are asked to please keep to the restricted area.

- Use of the pool is **restricted to keyholder's pre-school and school age children** and house guests of school age.
- Keys are not transferable.
- **ANY CHILD UNACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT (over 16 years of age) MAY NOT USE OR ENTER THE POOL AREA.**
- **GATE MUST BE KEPT LOCKED AT ALL TIMES.**
- Each adult must take charge of no more than four children.
- Forbidden practices:
 - Running around the pool
 - Running, jumping or diving into the pool
 - Hairclips or ribbons in pool
 - Boogie boards, surf boards, kayaks are not to be used
 - Consumption of alcohol in school grounds
 - Climbing fences and buildings
 - Eating in pool area
 - Glass containers in pool area
 - Smoking or vaping in school grounds
 - Dogs in or around the pool area
- No dogs are to be in or around the pool area.
- The pool key will give you access to the toilets in the outside toilet block (end Room 7 – the door will lock itself on exiting).
- Children using the toilet are to be accompanied by an adult – any other children are to be taken with you or another adult is to supervise them if they remain in the pool.
- Commonsense and co-operation are essential. If the pool is crowded, adults in charge should share out the time in smaller groups.
- Please be considerate to neighbours. Keep noise at an acceptable level.
- **IMPORTANT:** Last persons out should check the dressing sheds, and ensure the gate is securely locked.

The above rules are for the safety of **ALL** children - **STRICT ENFORCEMENT IS ESSENTIAL**
Swimmers must be under surveillance at all times - accidents happen quickly.
