Available daily

Children order by filling in an order form from the box on the bench outside the office each morning before 9.00am and placing the order, along with the correct money, into the box. Lunches are collected from the office at lunchtime.

SUBWAY LUNCHES

Available each Friday

Subway lunches are ordered online and orders must be placed by 9.00am each Friday morning at the latest to ensure your child receives their lunch that day. Lunches are delivered to school just before lunch and children collect them from the office at 12.45pm.

(orders cannot be taken by the school)

- Select the 'SUBWAY School Lunch Programme' option
- For the first time, create an account by following the prompts (NB – the Subway App can't be used for the School Lunch Programme)
- Select your school and complete the 'student name' and 'class' questions (If your child is in a named class such as the Fantail Room rather than a numbered class, please use room number 30 then put the name of the class in the 'Special Instructions' box on the Confirm Order page)
- Follow steps 1 to 3 to build your order
- If your child would like mayonnaise or BBQ sauce, ask for this in the 'Special Instructions' box on the Confirm Order page
- Confirm your order and pay via Credit Card
- If you are making multiple orders for multiple children you will need to finalise payment for the first order before starting the process over again for subsequent orders.
