Their commitment to the weeks of training and enthusiasm was remarkable.

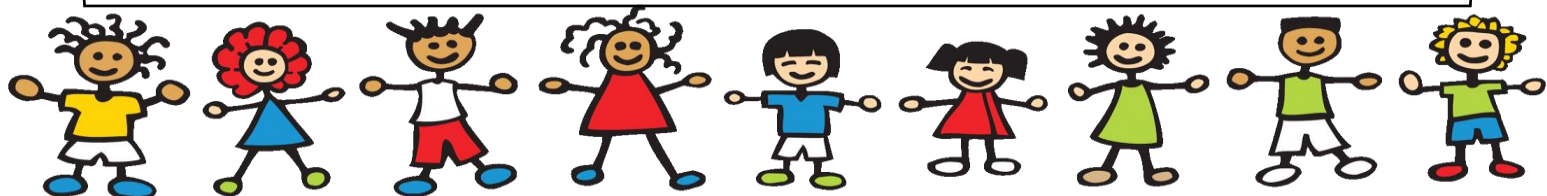

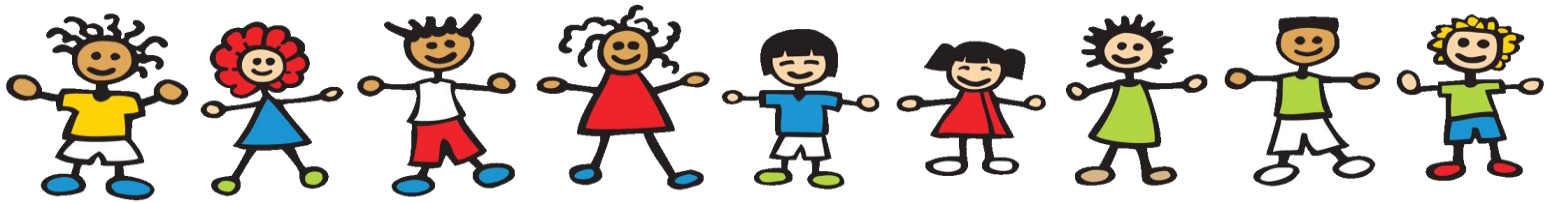
Ski Trip
