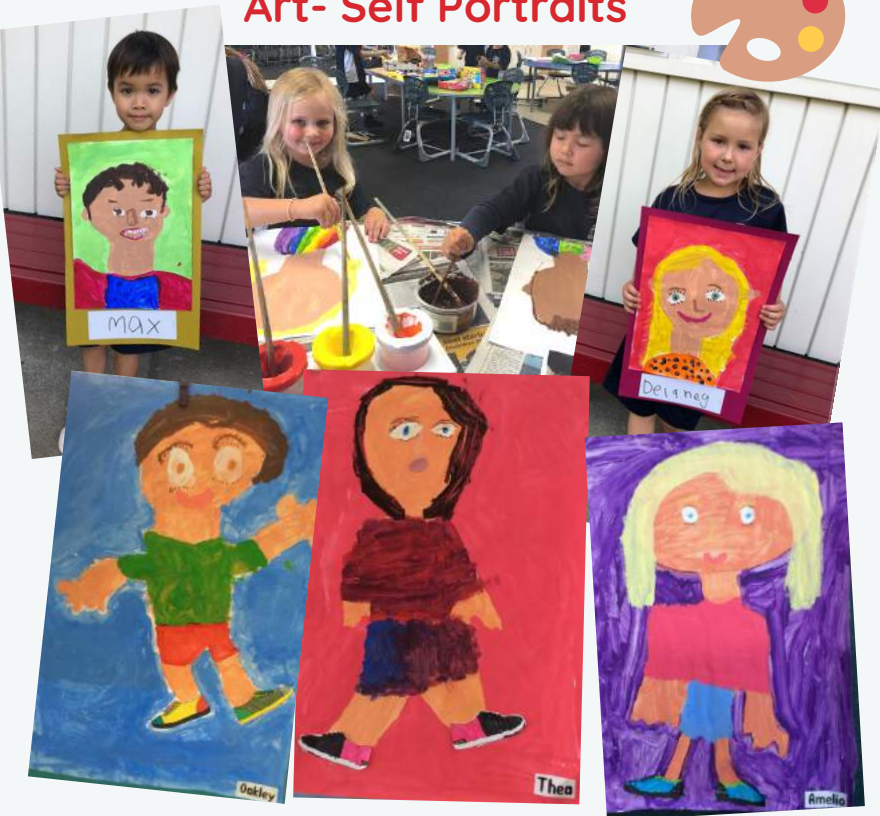
Physical Education
