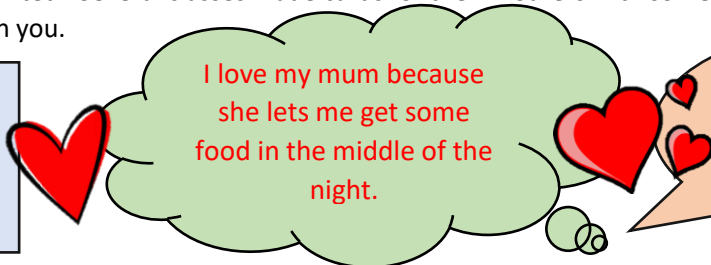
Dear Parents and Caregivers

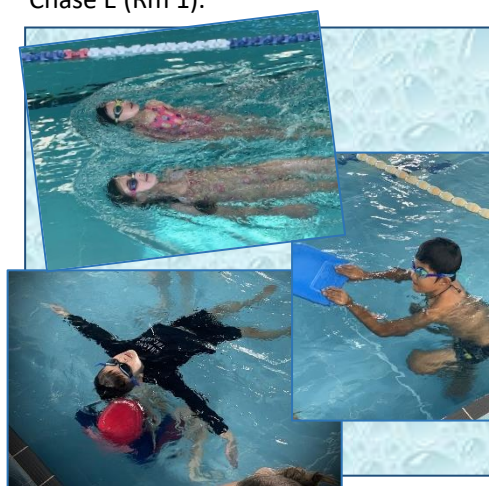

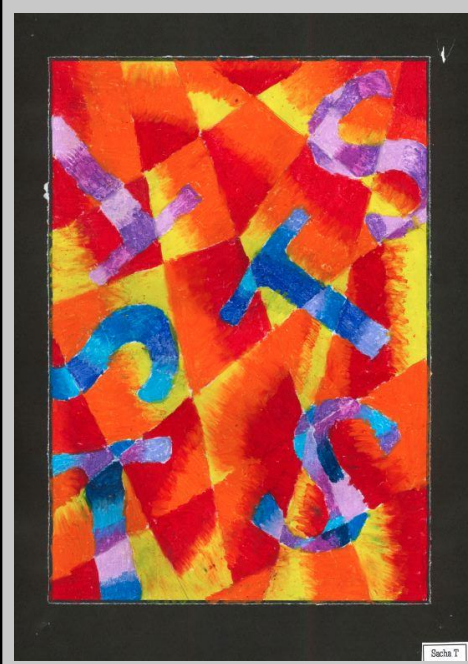

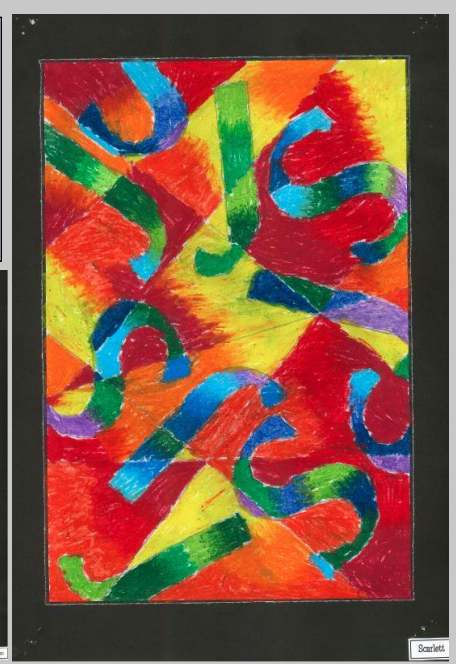
